ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS: During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online entries: 50%; Paper entries: 50%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to adjust the limits as they see fit.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER ENVELOPE: A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned. No hand deliveries will be accepted within the first 24 hours of opening date and time.

ELIGIBLE DOGS: These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP/PAL) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing Number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs, and bitches in season are ineligible to compete.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, fax entries cannot be accepted. Overnight mail entries should have the "no signatures" box checked. Entries must be on an AKC form (that includes the disclaimer form on the back) in order to be acceptable. Please ensure only AKC recognized titles are used on all entries.

Confirmation of entries will be e-mailed within a day or so of receipt as they are entered into the computer. Final entry confirmation and judging schedule will be e-mailed or sent to the entry address as soon as possible after the closing date. If you have not received confirmation at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and NSF checks will be charged \$25.00.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry or that you show it at the time of check-in. Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division. **MEASURING WILL TAKE PLACE AT 8 AM, JULY 24 & 25, 2010.**

If there is an AKC Agility Rep at the trial, all dogs entered will need to be measured for their permanent AKC jump card if they don't already have one. This includes dogs jumping at the 24" & 26" heights.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Move-Ups: Move up to a higher class will be allowed if received by the Trial Secretary in writing by Monday, 19 July 2010, at 6:00 PM AST. E-mail is acceptable. Please use: Striebich@aol.com Move-ups for Sunday will be allowed if received by the trial secretary in writing within 30 minutes after release of the final run scores on Saturday. No move-ups will be accepted after that time.

Walk Throughs and Warm ups: Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. A warm up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided. **There will be no Novice obstacle familiarization at these trials, per amended AKC regulations.**

There will be no refunds for duplicate entries of the same dog or for entries withdrawn after the closing date, with one exception: Handlers with bitches who come into season after the closing date and before or during the trial, may receive a refund of half the entry fee with written notice given to the trial chairman. If the dog/handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason, there will be no refund.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the AKC.

Classes: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The trial secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups) after the closing date of the trial. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in with the gate steward and be at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The Judge is not obligated to wait for any exhibitor.

Awards: A dark green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. First, second, third or fourth place ribbons shall be the following colors: First Place – Blue, Second Place – Red, Third Place – Yellow, Fourth Place - White

Trophies: All dogs entered in these trials will receive a stuffed dog toy (value \$2 to \$3). New Title ribbons will be awarded. Double Q Ribbons will be awarded to dogs earning a Double Q in Excellent B. MACH, PAX, and Titling ribbons will be awarded to those earning titles at these trials.

Catalogs: In order to keep costs down, we are offering pre-paid catalogs (see form attached), a limited number of catalogs will be available at the trials.

Obstacles: Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Event Cancellation: If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made

Important Information for Exhibitors:

Training on Grounds: Chapter 4, Section 15 of the Regulations for Agility Trials states "No agility obstacle training is allowed on the show grounds except for the use of the warm-up jump". The "grounds" include the entire Boys & Girls Club sports complex.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs may wear a flat buckle or rolled leather collar. There shall be no attachments or tags, hanging or otherwise, allowed. The dog may run without a collar. Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring or at the practice jump.

There will be an exercise area provided for the dogs. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area(s) soiled by their dogs. Exhibitors will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and setup areas.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Dog Obedience Training Club of Anchorage, Inc. or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises. Failure to do so will result in action by the Trial Committee.

The Trial Committee may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the AKC.

A dog that in the opinion of the judge attacks any person in the ring, shall be disqualified. The judge will excuse a dog that attacks another dog in the ring or if the judge witnesses a dog attack another dog while entering or exiting the ring.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Regular Classes: Are offered in Standard, JWW and FAST.

Preferred Classes: Are offered in the same divisions as Standard, JWW and FAST. (Preferred Novice is not divided into A & B divisions). The Preferred Class is open to any dog eligible to enter in an agility trial, as defined by AKC "Regulations for Agility Trials". The handler may choose to enter the Preferred Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard, Regular JWW, or Regular FAST classes at any trial. The dog must be entered **only** in the Preferred or Regular Classes, with no crossover between them at the same set of trials.

Novice: Novice A is for handlers and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title. Novice B is for dogs that have acquired any AKC novice title (either NA or NJ) or persons who have handled a dog to an AKC agility title or for agility judges.

Open: For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Open title but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

Height divisions- Regular Classes-dog measured at the withers:

8" –for dogs 11" and under

12"-for dogs 14" and under

16"-for dogs 18" and under

20"-for dogs 22" and under

24"-for dogs over 22"

26" – at the owner's discretion

Height divisions- Preferred Classes

4" – for dogs 11" and under

8" - for dogs 14" and under

12"- for dogs 18" and under

16"- for dogs 22" and under

20"- for dogs over 22"
