MAKE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: DOG OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB OF ANCHORAGE, INC. (DOTCA)

NSF or returned checks require cash payment of entry fee plus \$30.00 NSF fee and any bank fees. *Conditional, Unsigned, Incomplete or Telephone Entries Cannot Be Accepted.*

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Trial Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

IF A DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry. The show giving club may decline any entries for cause or indebtedness to the club over thirty days past due. The club may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show premises due to disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof for such action.

To be acceptable an entry must be submitted with the required entry fee on an official AKC entry form. DOGS entered in a wrong class may not be transferred to another class. **HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE THEIR DOGS ARE ENTERED IN THE CORRECT CLASS.** Changes must be received in writing prior to the closing date and time. DOTCA will refund 50% of entry fee to entrants whose bitch comes in season after entries have closed. Refund may be obtained by sending a written statement to trial secretary. The Trial Secretary must receive the certificate minimum of 30 minutes prior to start of judging

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING DOGS

Select the classes for which your dog is eligible, then fill out the entry completely. Please TYPE or PRINT clearly, the Club assumes no liability for wrong information.

ONLY include AKC Titles, OFA and CERF numbers (titles from other venues are not printed in AKC catalogs)

Special trophies may be donated based on official AKC titles or offered for Junior Handlers so make sure your titles are correct. OFA and CERF numbers are permitted in the show catalog. The complete number should be written on the entry form following the dog's name. If not using the attached entry form, please make sure you are using the most current one available on AKC through downloading.

EVENT RULES

ALL DOGS shall be held on leash except when in the Obedience Ring. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. The use of corrective devices is strictly prohibited on the show grounds. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities or building/ parking regulations.

EXHIBITORS and HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and for cleaning up after their dogs.

The club will designate a monitored warm-up area with a jump for use during designated times.

DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT in ample time before their scheduled judging time and they may be removed as soon as they are no longer needed for competition. Once brought into the grounds, a dog entered in this show may not be withheld from competition unless excused by a Judge, Veterinarian or the Show Committee.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance to the judging ring when the class is scheduled to be judged. Owners or handlers of the dog are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in the show ring. Only dogs entered at this show are allowed on show grounds.

THE MANAGEMENT will exercise every precaution for the safety of the dogs exhibited and it is understood that neither the club nor the management nor the landlord will be responsible for the loss of, damage to, or any other damage caused by any dog for any cause.

THE TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises. Failure to do so will result in action by the show committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dog Obedience Training Club of Anchorage does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

AN EXERCISE AREA will be provided outside the building. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area soiled by their dogs.

Please be sure to read the rules about class eligibility before entering obedience & rally classes.

DESCRIPTIONS OF REGULAR, OPTIONAL TITLING AND NON-REGULAR CLASSES ARE AVAILABLE IN THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB OBEDIENCE AND RALLY REGULATIONS (AMENDED TO JANUARY 1, 2010).

(Not in AKC regulations) Versatile Veterans Non-Regular Obedience Class -

The Versatile Veterans Class shall be for dogs that are at least seven (7) years of age. The dog may NOT compete in this class if it is also entered in the regular open or utility classes. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. There will be no group exercises in this class. Dogs entered in this class are to jump at the nearest higher multiple of 2 to half of the dog's height at the withers.

All dogs must perform the Signal Exercise as described in the regular utility class OR the heel free and figure 8 exercise as described in the regular open class (25 points). Seven exercises from the Open and Utility regular classes (Drop on Recall, Retrieve on the Flat, Retrieve over the High Jump, Moving Stand, Scent Discrimination, Directed Retrieve, Directed Jumping) are available. The dog must perform five of the seven exercises, with the handler indicating which exercises will be excluded at the time that the armband is picked up during check-in. The open/utility exercises will be performed as in the regular classes, with each exercise being worth 35 points. Total points for the class will be 200.

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY MOVE-UPS: After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. **Move ups are only allowed between the Regular Classes (i.e. Novice to Open) in obedience, per AKC regulations. Move-ups are NOT allowed between one Optional Titling class and another (i.e. Graduate Novice to Graduate Open) OR between Optional Titling classes and the Regular classes (i.e. Beginner Novice and Regular Novice).**

ENTRY FEES: (Please see note below for overnight deliveries-none accepted without waiver release)

\$27.00 for first Regular Obedience entry, \$18.00 for second regular obedience entry of same dog. Non-regular obedience classes: \$15 for single entries; \$15 per pair in Brace; \$40 per Team **Each first Obedience entry includes 50 cents AKC recording fee & \$3.00 Event Service Fee. Each second entry includes \$3.00 Event Service Fee.**

\$27.00 for first Regular Rally entry, \$18.00 for second regular rally entry of same dog. Non-regular rally classes: \$15 single entries; \$15 per pair in Rally Pairs and \$40.00 per Team in Rally Team **Each Rally entry Includes AKC \$3.00 recording fee.**

NOTE: Do not count Sunday as 2nd entry from Saturday & Do not count Rally as a 2nd entry to Obedience.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS: 8:00PM Wednesday, 5 October 2011, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed, except as provided for in chapter 11 Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. The Program of Judging will be mailed to each entrant prior to the show. This can be done electronically for those who provide email information on entry forms.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
